WHAT IS A MEDICAL CAMERA?

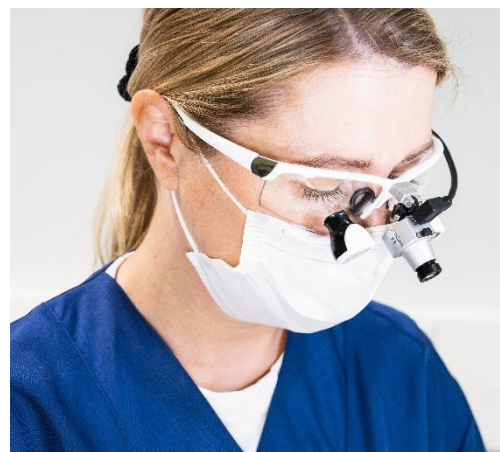
- A medical camera can be used to take high quality images or videos for the purpose of:
 - before & after comparisons,
 - treatment progress,
 - condition progression,
 - patient education and information, insurance documentation,
 - professional consultations and
 - home care instructions.
- Data will be stored locally in a software gallery.
- Data can be uploaded to Cloud services.
- Novocam Medical Innovations (NMI) is the manufacturer of the medical cameras sold as the brands *futudent*, *novocam* and *vetcam*.
- Images can be imported to other medical software.
- Data will not be shared without your consent.

PATIENT DATA PRIVACY

- By default, images are labelled only with a time stamp.
- Data is encrypted and anonymous when it is sent to the Cloud.
- Names and descriptions for the image are entered and stored separately from the images.
- No personal data is attached to the image.
- Only people with a secure link can pair the image and the description.
- Data is not sold or shared with 3rd parties.
- End users of NMI cameras are Data Controllers according to the EU General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR).
- All NMI Cloud services are hosted in the EU.



YOUR RIGHTS

- You have the right to give or withhold your consent to taking images and sharing data.
- If you consent today, you may withdraw your consent later. Your doctor will be able to remove the data from the Novocam Cloud records and their local PC.
- You are entitled to receive further information about the purposes for which your data will be processed and who will have access to it. Your doctor can tell who can help you if you would like more information.
- You have a right to see which data is stored about you and to have corrections made to any errors you find.
- You may also have the right to block the use of or erase your data. Restricting the processing of your data can include not consenting to the data being put on the Cloud systems for sharing.
- The camera user is responsible for your data collection and deciding how it is used. They should address your requests concerning your data in 30 days.
- The camera user has the duty to safely handle your data and to notify you if a breach of data security occurs.
- If you have any concerns about the way in which your data is processed, you may contact your treating doctor or your relevant national data protection authority.
